

Northern Adirondack Basketball Club

Mission Statement

The purpose of the NAC Basketball Club is to:

1. Provide support and assistance to the NAC basketball program.
2. Expose club members to college level play through attending at least one college basketball game per year.
3. Develop scholarship and communication skills.

Eligibility

The NAC Basketball Club is open to all students in grades 6-12, and is not exclusive to basketball athletes. There is no grade point average requirement for club members; however, all members must meet the academic eligibility requirements set in the NACS Middle and High School Code of Conduct. Elected officers and the advisor have the right to deny entry or revoke membership to those who do not represent the Northern Adirondack School District in a positive way or who have violated the NACS Middle and High School Code of Conduct.

By-Laws

1. Members must attend meetings. Failure to attend meetings can result in termination of club membership as determined by the club advisor.
2. Members will elect officers. The offices are President, Vice-President, Secretary, and Treasurer.
3. Members will attend at least 1 home game for each level that he/she does not play at. Members are expected to support competing basketball athletes in a manner consistent with the NACS Middle and High School Code of Conduct. Members are encouraged to attend as many home games as possible.
4. Members will enjoy a chaperoned trip to a college where they will attend a college basketball game.
5. Members will work at any home basketball tournaments that may be scheduled.
6. Members must collaborate and support fellow members.
7. Any additions or deletions to the by-laws will be put to an open vote to all club members, and then officially recorded. Quorum must be met before a vote can take place. Quorum is set at 75% of the total membership.
